New Business

Race Season 2016-2017:

Proposed dates pending NWSDA schedule.

Race dates and pointed classes will be discussed at Summer Meeting.

Possibility of additional race:

Parking is an issue at Dogtown Winter Derby. Possibility of breaking it up into two weekends. Big teams one weekend, small teams another?? Race committee needs to work on race rules.

Do not feel Priest Lake would bring a high enough attendance.

Drag Races:

Grass Drag Race is not pointed yet. Will have to be a different pointing system. Need race rules.

Judge S has talk with the city for use of Steilacoom Park as a location for the grass drags. Will not cost the club anything unless we want a sanican brought in on the mushers parking side. Public restrooms are available across the field. Benches are available and can be moved wherever we need them. Would be a small cost for race supplies Grass drags proposed date Nov 19th

Adding a 3 dog class to our races:

Would have to offer bike and scooter. Races would go from 6 classes to 8. Would make the race day longer.

IESDA might be open to adding a 3 dog class

Would there be enough interest to reach the required 3 teams for pointing. Race rules need to be made.

Race committee will need to work on race rules and course.

Race Budget:

Proposed items to add to race budget. Race bibs, 1 more set of banners, sanicans, KRS bumper stickers, paint for drags.
